Call to Worship From Psalm 9

The LORD is a stronghold for the oppressed, a stronghold in times of trouble
Those who know your name put their trust in you
For you, O LORD, have not forsaken those who seek you
I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart
I will recount all of your wonderful deeds
I will be glad and exult in you; I will sing praise to your name, O Most High
The Lord be with you. **And with your spirit.**
Let us worship God!

God calls His people into worship, not the other way around. His Word is the only thing that can truly draw our hearts into worship in Spirit and Truth. And so, we begin here.

Songs of Worship and Praise

Please feel free to worship in the way that the Lord is leading. Whether standing or sitting, hands raised or kneeling before the Lord. There is no required posture.

The Bible tells us to let the Word of Christ dwell within us richly by “singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs.” Thus, we sing of what God has done, and about our delight in Him.

First Sunday of Advent Isaiah 7.10-14

¹⁰Again the Lord spoke to Ahaz: ¹¹“Ask a sign of the Lord your God; let it be deep as Sheol or high as heaven.” ¹²But Ahaz said, “I will not ask, and I will not put the Lord to the test.” ¹³And he said, “Hear then, O house of David! Is it too little for you to weary men, that you weary my God also? ¹⁴Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign. Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

An Advent Prayer

Heavenly Father, we praise you for sending your Son Immanuel, God with us.
Thank you for promising the sign of Immanuel, despite our stubbornness and pride. Thank you for drawing near to us, instead of waiting for us to draw near to you. Thank you for entering the brokenness of this world, instead of abandoning it to its fate. This Advent, let us see, hear, know, and feel the truth: that you are Immanuel, God with us. We are never alone when we have you.
In the name of Jesus, our Immanuel, we pray. Amen.

Prayer isn’t just a private interaction with God, it is also a part of public worship. God calls His people to speak to Him as one unified body. “My” prayers become “Our” prayers as we cry out to Him together.

Confession of Faith Adapted from Philippians 2

We believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God, who did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped. Instead, He emptied Himself, taking the form of a servant, and was born in our likeness. We believe He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death—even death on a cross. We believe God has highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the Name above every other, that at the Name of Jesus, every knee shall bow—in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. We believe we are called to rejoice in Him, and shine His light, as we daily work out our great Salvation. AMEN.

Preaching of God’s Word Mark 1.9-13

“Jesus Under the Sun – War & Peace”

⁹In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. ¹⁰And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens being torn open and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. ¹¹And a voice came from heaven, “You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased.” ¹²The Spirit immediately drove him out into the wilderness. ¹³And he was in the wilderness forty days, being tempted by Satan. And he was with the wild animals, and the angels were ministering to him.

Because God has spoken to us through His Word we strive to proclaim what it says and teach what it means. Through it, the Church receives training, correction, encouragement, and a deeper experience of the gospel of Jesus.

Benediction Numbers 6.24-26
