Call to Worship: Psalm 27 (Select Verses)

"The LORD is my light and my salvation; Whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? You have said, 'Seek my face.' My heart says to you, 'Your face, LORD, do I seek.' Teach me your way, O LORD and lead me on a level path. Wait for the LORD. Be strong, and let your heart take courage" - Opening Prayer -

God calls His people into worship, not the other way around. His Word is the only thing that can truly draw our hearts into worship in Spirit and Truth. And so, we begin here.

Songs of Worship and Praise

Please feel free to worship in the way that the Lord is leading. Whether standing or sitting, hands raised or kneeling before the Lord. There is no required posture.

The Bible tells us to let the Word of Christ dwell within us richly by "singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs." Thus, we sing of what God has done, and about our delight in Him.

Second Sunday of Advent: Micah 5.1-5a

Now muster your troops, O daughter of troops; siege is laid against us; with a rod they strike the judge of Israel on the cheek. But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the clans of Judah, from you shall come forth for me one who is to be ruler in Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days. Therefore he shall give them up until the time when she who is in labor has given birth; then the rest of his brothers shall return to the people of Israel. And he shall stand and shepherd his flock in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord his God. And they shall dwell secure, for now he shall be great to the ends of the earth. And he shall be their peace.

An Advent Prayer

Heavenly Father, we praise you for sending your Son to be Immanuel, God with us. Thank you for the promise of a Good Shepherd, of one who would be great to the ends of the earth; Though Bethlehem was little and weak, you sent your promised one there, and changed our world forever. In the midst of trouble, conflict and fear, we praise you Father that all who look to Jesus can dwell secure; We abide in the peace that surpasses understanding. This advent season, help us to look afresh at the One who came, and promised to come again. Be our peace.

Prayer isn't just a private interaction with God, it is also a part of public worship. God calls His people to speak to Him as one unified body. "My" prayers become "Our" prayers as we cry out to Him together.

Benediction: Numbers 6.24-26

"The LORD bless you and keep you; ... and give you peace."

Because God has spoken to us through His Word we strive to proclaim what it says and teach what it means. Through it, the Church receives training, correction, encouragement, and a deeper experience of the gospel of Jesus.

Followers of Jesus are invited to His table where He spiritually feeds His people. Though these elements are common bread and wine, they symbolize His body and blood and "preach" to our senses that Christ abides in us and we abide in Him.

God gets the final word in the worship service. And with it He chooses to bless His people. That is what the word benediction means: "blessing." Go in the peace of His blessing!
